PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE

Jamestown Community School Students will once again take part in the 2022 Premier's Reading Challenge. All students from R – 12 can enter.

What is the Premier's Reading Challenge?

The Premier's Reading Challenge is a literacy engagement program that was introduced by the Premier in 2004 to encourage students to read more books and enjoy reading as well as improve literacy levels.

How do students complete the Challenge?

The Challenge requires students to read 12 books between the beginning of the school year and early September.

This week, students will receive a Reading Record (this may be kept in class by homegroup teachers). Some of the 12 books must be from the Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC) Booklist. There are lots of PRC books to borrow from the library, many marked with a PRC sticker.



Audiobooks and e-books can be included and it's important to note that any book in a series can be counted as a PRC book. **Libraries SA has a free e-book and audiobook app which can be downloaded and used.**
